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Minnesota State Overview

- 26 Colleges, 7 Universities, 54 Campuses; growing online presence



Minnesota State Secondary School Partnerships

- Dual Enrollment Programs Minnesota Postsecondary Enrollment Options Act
 - ✓ Traditional PSEO 10th through 12th grade students earn college credit offered on postsecondary campus or taken online
 - Concurrent Enrollment 9th through 12th grade students take college-credit courses taught by credentialed secondary teachers on the high-school campus
 - Perkins Consortia 24 consortia of Minnesota State colleges and Minnesota school districts organized across the state to support Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs
